

7th K mart Store To Open in Denver

The seventh K mart store in the Denver area—and the 11th in Colorado—at W. 84th Ave. and Huron St., will open to the public at 10 a.m. Thursday.

Denver officials and top executives of the parent S. S. Kresge Co., including Emery H. Larson, sales director and merchandise manager, will take part in an opening ceremony immediately before the public opening.

Edmond Becorest will manage the new store, which will feature numerous departments, a complete automotive center and a snack bar.

Becorest said that more than

150 Denver area residents will be employed full time and additional personnel will be employed part-time.

Harry B. Cunningham, who rose from store manager to president of the Kresge company, opened the first K mart in a suburb in Detroit in 1962.

During the same week as the Denver opening, four other K marts will be opened in Michigan, Minnesota and Ohio, increasing the number of K marts to 465 in the United States, Puerto Rico, Canada and Australia.
