Burned-Out K mart To Reopen Thursday

The K mart division of S. S. Kresge Co. has announced it will reopen on Thursday as a completely rebuilt operation the K mart store at W. Belleview Ave. and S. Broadway which was destroyed by fire November 1972.

Officials said Henry R. Salby, general manager of the store, will return to Denver from a K mart management post Sparks, Nev., to manage the new 84,000-square-foot outlet which has been built on the original Englewood site.

Before joining the Kresge management training program in 1951 in Minneapolis, Salby served in the U.S. Marine Corps and graduated from the University of Minnesota.

He was named as a store manager for the first time in

1958 in Minneapolis, and man-jaged three more Kresge stores before becoming a district manager in the firm's Midwest region. He was a K mart manager in Wichita, Kan. before coming to Denver in 1971.
